RE: Board of Supervisors November 16, 2021 Meeting, Agenda Item 45, 2021 Redistricting Discussion of Proposed Draft District Boundary Maps

Dear Members of the Board:

The Rancho Cordova City Council met on November 15, 2021, and during that meeting Council Members reviewed and discussed the contents of the November 2, 2021 letter sent to you regarding the County's Redistricting effort.

Based on new information provided by County staff indicating that it would be difficult to keep the city entirely within one district, one Council Member proposed a variation of Map 203 and a change in policy direction. The Council voted on the input, and on a 3-2 vote (Noes: Terry, Pulipati), the motion to revise the Council's previous input to you carried.

The variation of Map 203 that the City Council is proposing provides for the city to be split into two districts, District 3 and District 5, and this could potentially be accomplished in the following way:

- Rancho Cordova east of Sunrise Blvd. to the city limits would be in District 5
- Rancho Cordova west of Sunrise Blvd. to the city limits would be in District 3
- Foothill Farms, Mather, and eastern La Riviera would be in District 3
- Gold River could be either in District 3 or in District 5

While all Council Members recognize that a more ideal situation would be to keep the city intact in one district, the proposed variation of Map 203 would be amenable to the majority of the Council.

We ask the Board to take into account the City Council's feedback and consider the proposed revisions to Map 203 that reflect these requests.
