Land Park Community Association supports **Redistricting Map #203** with three important points of consideration focusing on **the benefits of a common community of interest**:

- The new District 1 representation would unify the Community of Interest of Land Park, Upper Land Park, South Land Park, Sierra-Curtis Park and Holywood Park, acknowledging Greater Land Park ("The Parks") as both a planning unit of the General Plan and as a political unit accountable for the plan implementation – thus, better assuring the outcome of "livability" as defined by the residents.
- District 1 (to include Newton-Booth and Southside neighborhood) could address the future of our "Main Street" (the Broadway W/X corridor) with a common vision and single voice, meeting the challenges including; the Broadway Complete Streets renovation, Broadway intensified redevelopment, the W.Sacramento-Broadway bridge, and the Homeless Sheltering challenges.
- 3. District 1 would allow Greater Land Park to share responsibility for the management and future development of the City Center service core and transportation network, engaging a large number of our current and retired City and State workforce in residence.
